General Responsibilities of the SAVP Cabinet

- Making calls during registration
- Work with the regional SAVP on what Social Action looks like for the entire year throughout the region
- Help lead Social Action Programs and assist as needed with program writing
- Be track leaders at Fallinter, CWR's Social Justice themed event (Being on the SAVP cabinet means that you are available to attend Fallinter, which is [insert date here] 2018)
- Serve as resource for the region in terms of Social Justice, and be committed to leading by example in all aspects
- Help as needed in leading programs, mixers, etc.

Special Projects Coordinator (1 person)

- Assists with special projects and events, such as J-Serve and subregional social action events. This position will also help with any new initiatives the regional SAVP wants to put forward throughout the year, I.E. social media campaigns, finding people to write blog posts regarding Social Action, etc
- Helps find ways to incorporate Social Action into regional events, beyond the hour long program

Temple Youth Group (TYG) Social Action Chairperson

- Connects TYG Social Action Vice Presidents with regional as well as North American Social Action goals and priorities
- Makes sure that each TYG SAVP is working with their synagogue's adult leadership and Youth Professional to bridge the gap between adults and teens when it comes to Social Justice
- Works with the SAVPs across the region to coordinate social action programming and experiences, as well as serve as a resource for the SAVPs.
 - This means that you need to be up to date and educated about current social action initiatives that NFTY is doing on a regional level and a north american level, as well as informed about social justice on a broader level
- Work to incorporate the Social Action work of TYGs into regional events

Programming Assistants (2 people)

- Assists with the writing and brainstorming of programs for regional events, and providing feedback on the social action components of each event
- Helps with the development of the Social Action theme for the year
- instrumental in generating ideas of experimental and interactive programming
