Cabinet Positions:

- 2 New Member Mentors
- 2 Family Program Leaders
- 1 Mixer Chair
- up to 5 general cabinet members

CWR General Cabinet Responsibilities:

Members will also make pre-event phone calls getting members to come to CWR events. Additionally being on Cabinet, members will be at all or at least a majority of NFTY events for the 5779-5780 term.

MVP Cabinet/General MVP cabinet member responsibilities:

Being on MVP Cabinet will involve being very outgoing in the region! Cabinet members will welcome others into the region and help bring a sense of community by getting to know everyone alongside the Membership Vice President. Cabinet members are expected to be able to join regular calls and check ins before, after, and in between events. General cabinet members will be able to help wherever they choose and it is generally a position with less responsibility as the others.

New Member Mentors:

This position requires responsibility regarding new members of CWR. Including phone calls preceding the event, interacting at the event, and making sure new members feel comfortable. And the main responsibility during events is leading the new member program. (teaching the cheer, traditions, what NFTY is, etc)

Family Program Leaders:

These leaders will be a major part of the process for the family program. They will help co-write the programs as well as lead them. In addition, these leaders will be doing a lot of separate calls with the MVP to write programs and modify the families/cousins.

Mixer Chair:

The mixer chair is essentially someone who gets to help out with mixers at all events. This can include leading them, or writing them. The mixer chair will also work with the MVP on gathering the necessary materials and more.
